Thimphu & Paro (B/L/D)

After breakfast, retrace your drive back to Paro. In Paro visit Tiger's Nest Monastery (Taksang) and Farm House, National Museum and Local Market Overnight at Hotel

Paro Depart (B)

After breakfast, transfer to the airport in time for your departure flight to onward destination.
